



BILL LANDRY IS THE FEATURED SPEAKER

AT WATeR'S ANNUAL MEETING OCT. 15



Bill Landry is the voice, host/narrator, and co-producer of *The Heartland Series*, now in its 31st year of running on WBIR-TV, in Knoxville, Tn. Since it began in 1984, over 1,900 short features have been produced, including 150 half-hour specials.

Bill is deeply rooted in the Appalachian region, and serves on the board of the Sequoyah Birthplace Museum, Vonore, Tn. He's a member of the Tennessee Historical Commission, having been appointed by Gov. Bill Haslam. In addition to his guest speaking, he continues to write, lecture and perform. He's married to Sandra Weaver and they live happily in Knoxville, TN.

Meeting Location

The meeting will be held this year at the **Vonore Baptist Church**, 714 Church St., Vonore. Meet and Greet plus an opportunity to view exhibits begins at 6:30. The meeting starts at 7:00 and will conclude no later than 8:30PM. **Directions: from Vonore**—Rt. 411 and Rt. 360 stop light in Vonore, travel 1/2 mile east on Rt. 411 and turn north (right) on Church Street, continue 1/2 mile to the Baptist Church. (The road to the south of this Rt. 411 intersection is Niles Ferry Road, (the road that goes to the Kahite neighborhood). **Directions from Tellico Village:** take Rt. 72 south to Rt. 411, turn left, continue about 2 miles and turn left on church St. (opposite the road that goes to the Kahite neighborhood) and continue 1/2 mile to the Baptist Church.
